

The most characterises building of the town is the roman-catholic church (Petőfi tér), in secession style, a work of the famous architectures Kós Károly and Jánosky Béla. There are nine passion pictures - made form metal - along the road to the classic Passion-Chapel. In the cemetery lies Szőnyi István the famous artist. His former living house exists as a Memorial Museum (Bartóky u. 7.).

There is a private shipping-historical collection in Zebegény owned by Mr Farkas Vince, retired captain.
